- **Bag Check Service:** Free bag check service is available in the east lobby of the Coliseum where luggage can be stored for the day. Available Thursday and Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Wisconsin Customs, Tipping and Laws

Tipping: It is customary to tip 20 percent to anyone providing a service in the United States. This includes, but is not limited to taxi drivers, waiters and waitresses, bartenders, concierges and others. The customary greeting in the U.S. is usually a firm handshake with your right hand.

Laws: Please note that Wisconsin has strict smoking laws. You are only allowed to smoke in designated, outside areas. There is no smoking allowed in any buildings or tents at Expo. The legal age to consume alcohol is 21 years of age. The legal age to purchase tobacco or nicotine products is 18 years of age.

Show Weather

Wisconsin weather can be unpredictable. When packing and preparing, please keep the following in mind:

- Comfortable walking shoes are a must! Expo has miles of aisles in the Pavilions and Trade Show.
- Dressing in layers. Mornings can be quite cold and afternoons warm. Be sure to have a water-resistant jacket as well.
